The seminar shall discuss the history of digital currencies and the development of Bitcoin. We shall examine how Bitcoin operates in practice and review the potential positives, and negatives of Bitcoin as a currency. We will then focus upon how the advantages of Bitcoin have led to the legitimacy of the currency facing a challenge as it is adopted by criminals to facilitate frauds, money laundering and other online crime. Finally, the seminar will focus on the challenges faced by national regulators in monitoring and taxing the use of Bitcoin and investigating suspected misuse.

The problems faced by investigators engaged in tracing assets of defendants will also be considered, as it is predicted that the use of digital currencies in an attempt to defeat asset forfeiture legislation will become increasingly widespread. Defence lawyers will need to understand how evidence can (or cannot) be gathered in furtherance of the preparation of our client's defence.
