Free Software PDF Readers

There are many programs to read and write PDF documents. PDFreaders.org provides a frequently updated list of Free Software PDF Readers, respecting your basic four freedoms to use, study, share and improve them. This gives you control over your computer and helps protect your privacy. The list is managed by Fellows of the FSFE and is both vendor and platform neutral.

The Portable Document Format

The Portable Document Format (PDF) is a popular format to publish formatted text and documents. There are several different versions of it, some qualifying as an Open Standard, some certified by ISO and some encumbered by software patents. You might want to promote the versions that are Open Standards, because Open Standards guarantee interoperability, competition and choice.

Open Standards and PDF

PDF was created by Adobe Systems in 1993 and has been published in several versions since then. Standards based on subsets of the PDF specifications have also been published. PDFreaders.org features an overview of the different PDF versions and their status as an Open Standard.

What to do?

First of all start using a free PDF reader today! This will strengthen the Free Software Comunity and give us a chance to represent more people and their wish for Open Standards.

PDFreaders.org also offers buttons that webmasters can use instead of the "Get Adobe Reader" graphics. If you see a website claiming that Adobe Reader is required to read PDF documents, please let them know that this is not the case and point them to our website.
